**DOING JUSTICE** is a vehicle to expose local congregations to critical issues of justice and is designed to be informational, inspirational, experiential, and application-oriented.

**DOING JUSTICE** provides a venue for individuals, teams, and churches to make connections with those who have similar concerns in a way that will bring about a new view of God, identification with community, daring discipleship, sacrificial service and dangerous worship.

**DOING JUSTICE** is a catalyst to action where faith becomes real world, radical and effective.

**WHERE DO WE START?**

Participating churches will appoint a Doing Justice Conference Coordinator.

Each coordinator will attend a pre-conference planning session designed to fine-tune the conference for the needs and the interests of the participating churches. After the conference, the local church coordinator will attend an "Action" session to arrange ongoing support with other congregations who are pursuing similar justice issues.

**COMMITTED CHURCHES WILL INVEST \$1000 EACH TO COVER PROGRAM COSTS (PLUS \$10/PERSON TO COVER FOOD). THESE CHURCHES ARE ENCOURAGED TO BRING AS MANY AS 30 PEOPLE FOR HIGH-IMPACT INVOLVEMENT (INDIVIDUALS CAN REGISTER FOR \$60 EACH, INCLUDING FOOD)**
